It was **William Christopher Handy** (1873-1958), known as "The Father of the Blues" who is generally credited with starting the whole thing off. Today, he is still revered for his *Mister Crump* which was later titled *The Memphis Blues* (1913) and his enormously successful *St. Louis Blues* (1914) the so called "National Anthem of the Blues".
